

Pointe-à-Callière Objectif 2017

In preparation for Montréal's 375th anniversary, Pointe-à-Callière is continuing to work on the development of the remains of Fort Ville-Marie and Callière's estate, which will connect the Museum's main building to its new building via an underground link. Here is an update on the progress of current and upcoming work.

Temporary closure of Place D'Youville

The contractor has had to temporarily close Place D'Youville—from Saint-François-Xavier Street to Saint-Nicolas Street—to allow for the installation of pilings. The work should be complete by Friday, December 18. We apologize for the inconvenience.

Garbage collection

Residents of the closed portion of the street can leave their household trash outdoors at the same time and place as usual; the contractor will attend to placing it where the City can pick it up.

Schedule

Work is continuing as planned and according to schedule, which allows for our new building to open in May 2017. Please note, however, that a good portion of the exterior work, on Place D'Youville, should be complete by the end of summer 2016.

Construction hours

Work is generally carried out from Monday to Friday, between 7 am and 5 pm. Some tasks may need to be executed beyond these hours, on weekends (except Sundays).
