As we get ready to mark Montréal's 375th anniversary, Pointe-à-Callière is continuing its work to showcase the site where Montréal was founded and restore the remains of Fort Ville-Marie and of the first collector sewer built in North America. Here is a project update for early 2017.

Resumption of work

Work on the site resumed in the week of January 9, and is going very well. To speed things up and complete some steps in the process as quickly as possible, the crews will be working both during the day and in the evening. Most of this work will be done inside the future pavilion and the collector sewer. Some workers and machinery may be moving around on Place D'Youville in the coming weeks, starting on Monday, January 16. We are aware of the inconvenience this work may cause you, and we are doing our utmost to minimize its impact. Thank you for your valuable co-operation.
