In preparation for Montréal's 375th anniversary, Pointe-à-Callière is continuing to work on the development of the remains of Fort Ville-Marie and the city's first collector sewer. Here is an update on the progress of the work being carried out around the Museum.

Installation of pilings

Please note that as of Tuesday, October 4, 2016, the contractor will proceed with the installation of pilings for the aqueduct located on the south side of Place D'Youville, between de Callière and du Port Streets. This operation will be complete by the end this week, on Friday, October 7, 2016.

We were unable to inform you of this work any sooner, and we realize the inconvenience it may cause. We apologize for any difficulty you may experience; we are taking all necessary measures to minimize the work's impact. Thank you for your invaluable cooperation.

Schedule

The new building at 214 Place D'Youville is scheduled to open in May 2017. Please note, however, that a good portion of the exterior work, on Place D'Youville, should be complete by the end of autumn 2016.
